This is the usual order:

1. Individual college/university accounts.
2. OUAC or OCAS account.
3. Email from the university or college.
4. A package may be mailed to you.

**IT'S VERY IMPORTANT to check your individual accounts for college/university acceptances! After your February marks are sent in, a large round of admission offers are sent out.**

### U of T – Residence:

If you applied to any campus of the University of Toronto, you must go to your **MyRes** account (link on your Join U of T account) and confirm your residence application(s). Your **MyRes** login is the same as your Join U of T login. **March 31, 2019** is the deadline for confirming. Please come to the Guidance Office if you have any questions or require assistance.
